## SCHOOLS

- Ukiah Unified & Willits Schools will be closed the rest of the week due to the fire. We want to make sure we are fully staffed when students return to school. At this time, we plan to reopen on Monday, Oct. 16th and will communicate if that changes.

## MAIL

- USPS
