

**Redwood Coast Regional Center
Conflict of Interest Statement**

Per California Code of Regulations, Section 54533. Present or Potential Conflict of Interest Identified, Proposed Conflict Resolution Plan Content, Timelines for Submission of Proposed Conflict Resolution Plan, the following information is posted on the RCRC website.

54533 (f) To promote transparency, the regional center shall post on its internet website each completed Conflict of Interest Reporting Statement that identifies a present or potential conflict of interest that cannot be resolved within 30 calendar days of receipt by the regional center governing board or the regional center executive director, or within 30 calendar days of receipt of the Department's notification that it has independently identified a present or potential conflict of interest. The completed Conflict of Interest Reporting Statement shall remain on the regional center's internet website until the present or potential conflict of interest has been eliminated, or the individual has resigned his or her regional center position.
