It must be winter or at least fall as the rain has started in earnest up here. That means it is time to reflect on all we have and express some gratitude, though honestly that should be a daily thing.

Once a small intimate operation, RCRC continues to grow exponentially. We have more clients, (hovering around 5000 - double what we had when I started here) many more staff in more locations and (growing perhaps a little more slowly) more vendors. We are building an infrastructure we haven't had before, redoing our onboarding process. We now have the tools to provide our own augmentative and alternative communication demonstrations. I hope this exposure for everyone leads to increased access to these devices, the goal of course being to genuinely empower our clients to communicate with their own minds and hearts to determine their supports and services.

We are taking a focused look at implicit bias, equity, cultural humility and how to better serve our communities. We are rebuilding our clinics, outreach, best practices and relationships that were in place or maybe only budding before Covid. The legislature was good to our community again this last year and in the May budget revise. Our caseload ratios are the best they have ever been right now.

For all of the above and more else than I can count, I am grateful. I am grateful for each of you. The smile on your face and love in your heart that you bring to every client we serve through every task no matter how seemingly small shows. It makes a difference. You make a difference. That why you are here, right?



Are you passionate about helping your community and sharing about relationships and our rights? Do you want to learn more ways to be a great advocate for yourself and others? If you said yes, check out the new . . .

PEER EDUCATOR TRAINING ON SEXUAL HEALTH

For adult self-advocates who are clients of Redwood Coast Regional Center.

WHAT IS IT?

This is an online sex education class. You'll learn about sexuality. You'll learn how to share what you know with friends and peers and help them. The class is about the rights of people with disabilities and neurodivergent people. It covers safety, health, laws, and social issues.

Number of classes: 20 classes on Zoom

Length: Each class will be 1 hour & 30 min long, with a break.

Time: Thursdays, 5-6:30pm.

Dates: February 1 through June 13, 2024.

Participants will receive: A binder with resources, condoms, an educator kit, and a stipend of \$20 for each class attended.

WHAT WILL IT TEACH?

The class will teach some sexual health topics that are important to everyone. The students will choose what the rest of the topics will be. Here are examples of the topics:

- How to teach someone to put on a condom
- How to go to a doctor/clinic to access sexual healthcare
- How to support someone who is "coming out" as LGBTQ+
- How to help someone in an unhealthy relationship




