

Redwood Coast Regional Center Contract Awards FY 2018/2019

**2018/2019 Ukiah Valley Association \$150,401.00 Customized Accessible Vehicle and
For Habilitation Customized Employment Certified Staff- HCBS-PDF**

The first goal of this project will be to purchase a wheelchair accessible van with a lift, folding changing table and mechanical lift to safely move clients between their wheelchair and table to support clients to spend increased time in the community. The second goal of this project is for 8 staff members to attend trainings and complete requirements to achieve certificates in Community Employment with an Emphasis on Customized Employment to support clients to secure integrated employment.

2018/2019 Reaching For Independence \$210,120.00 Employment Specialists- HCBS-PDF

The goal of this project will be to hire and train 2 Employment Specialists (one in Humboldt County and one in Del Norte County) to expand capacity to assist clients to obtain competitive integrated employment.

2018/2019 Butler Valley – Carole Sund Center \$362,800.00 PCT Training, Program Developer, & Vehicles- HCBS-PDF

The goal of this project will be to have 2 employees become PCT trainers certified by the Learning Community. The service will also hire and train a Program Developer/Grant Writer to assist clients with accessing funding for their microenterprise(s) and integration of the Carole Sund Center Farm via the Community Supported Agriculture program. The funds will also be used to purchase 5 small vehicles to assist with promoting individualized opportunities for community inclusion to the people served by the Carole Sund Center.

2018/2019 Nyumbani, LLC. \$75,000 Residential Services- CRDP

The goal of this project will be to provide a licensed safe and medically supportive living environment for adults aged 18-59 with complex medical needs. This service may support individuals who require intermittent catheterization, restricted healthcare plans, diabetes management, suctioning, and support for typical age related health challenges. The grant request will support start-up costs for the necessary training and collaboration with community entities, securing a residential location, environmental accommodations, and general costs associated with service development for the residents associated with CPP.

2018/2019 Griffin-Hammis Assoc. \$40,000 Training/Consultation- CRDP

The goal of this project will be to contract with an agency that can provide two (northern and southern counties) 5 day onsite trainings for up to 35 employment service professionals and other stakeholders to earn a Basic Employment Services with an emphasis in Customized Employment Certificate of Achievement from the Association of Community Rehabilitation Educators (ACRE).

2018/2019 Coemella Cronin \$16,640 Quality Assurance Support Service- CRDP

The goal of this project will be to provide quality assurance and technical assistance to SLS, CCF, AFHA and other vendors that support people identified as requiring deflection services. The funds for this project will support up to four contractors in four counties to provide quality assurance and follow-up technical assistance.

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2018/2019 Benjamin Nicholson \$16,640 Quality Assurance Support Service- CRDP

The goal of this project will be to provide quality assurance and technical assistance to SLS, CCF, AFHA and other vendors that support people identified as requiring deflection services. 2018/2019 Leah Thompson \$16,640 Quality Assurance Support Service- CRDP

The goal of this project will be to provide quality assurance and technical assistance to SLS, CCF, AFHA and other vendors that support people identified as requiring deflection services. The funds for this project will support up to four contractors in four counties to provide quality assurance and follow-up technical assistance.

2018/2019 Janet Graser \$10,000 Clinical Testing Kits- CRDP

The goal of the project will be for RCRC to have a variety of assessment tools to assist clinicians and the local community in meeting assessment requirements. Testing kits will include forensic assessments, early intervention screening, and social sexual assessments. All testing kits will be administered by a licensed psychologist.

2018/2019 RCHDC \$500,000 Housing Development- CRDP

The goal of the project will be to provide affordable housing options for individuals who receive RCRC services using the *Community Placement Plan Guidelines for Purchasing and Developing Permanent Housing*. Rural Communities Housing Development Corporation has proposed new construction of an affordable 40-unit housing complex in Mendocino County. Ten of the 40 units (25%) will be set aside for use by RCRC clients only.
