2025/2026	WestMill	\$0	Level 7 Licensed Residential Home- No Start Up Funding
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Development of a Level 7 residential facility, for individuals with enhanced health care needs for 4 adults in Mendocino County. The home will serve adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) and aging (with approval of waiver) and enhanced health monitoring and care needs.

2025/2026	Brilliant Corners	\$62,208	Holding Costs Barnett Ave- CRDP
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This contract is a continuation of project 2122-5. Funding will be used to support lease payments to Brilliant Corners at a rate of \$6,912 per month for the nine-month period from May 2026 through January 2027 while RCRC determines the future use of the home and identifies a new service provider.
