3. DDS will require the tracking of remote services in e-billing effective 6/1/26.

 - c. This is required for services provided 6/1/26 and beyond.
 - d. Heather asks us to report a day as a remote service day if more than half the time was remote. If there are multiple days with an even split of remote to in-person work, then split the number of days reported evenly between the two.
 - e. Some e-billing invoices already show the reporting option, but reporting is not required until services beginning 6/1/26 and beyond. Although DDS has not provided a list of service codes, Heather suggests reporting the remote days on any invoice/ for any service code where the option is present on the invoice.
 - f. Original directive allowing remote services [Remote Services - Day Programs and Independent Living Services](#); 11/23/22 directive gives examples of remote services as video or telephone.
 - g. The Medicaid Telehealth definition allows phone, electronic mail systems, and can include video.
4. To qualify for the 10% QIP, new vendors must meet all of the preconditions including EVV registration (for programs like SLS/PA), HCBS Compliance (congregate residential or day service sites) and independent audit/review requirements. The new vendor must validate their service on Provider Directory and then complete the initial Provider Capacity survey within 60 days.
